
The COLLAB is an inclusive and collaborative group of Californian Early Childhood Education, Child Development, and content (literacy and





mathematics) faculty who developed curriculum modules to promote best practices for all children (linguistically, developmentally, and culturally) and empower early childhood educators. The COLLAB co-constructed modules are aligned with California's new literacy and mathematics standards for PK-3 ECE Educators and the Teaching Performance Expectations (TPE). The modules may serve as a resource for Early Childhood Education, Child Development, and Education program faculty to address California's new Standards 7 and 8 (*PK-3 ECE Specialist Instruction Credential Handbook*)

- Search for the module. Try putting "CSU Early Literacy or Mathematics" in the field, and the course should pop up!
- **5** Click on the course.

 - Import into an existing course

Click the Star \star on the course so you can easily find it.



If you try the search and the course does not appear, check your filters from a prior search.



Preview the entire course before importing the course.



If importing the course to a Canvas Shell, you may want to request a "sandbox" or other empty course shell to play with the materials.



If importing to an existing course shell with content, it may override the material.



Check with your campus Canvas support team for campus-specific issues.
